On all other levels, the Fire Alarm Office shall announce the threat level immediately after transmission of the signal only.

Members shall refer to the **addendum** to Standard Operating Procedures #61 **Operations and Response to Terrorist Incidents** dated March 31, 2003, for the appropriate measures to be taken for each Terrorism Threat Condition Level.
